

The new Louët Saxony S87

In 1974, Louët introduced a spinning wheel that broke with all traditions. The unique design was an instant success and has revolutionized the spinning industry all over the world. The basis of the traditional Louët design is functionality. The wheels are easy to use, easy to learn on, require minimal maintenance and are built to last many life times. Spinners at heart and designers by trade, Louët continuously keep coming up with new ideas and new equipment. In the last four years, we have seen the introduction of the roving carder, cotton hand cards, mini combs, Dutch combs, the folding S90 wheel, the S77 exerciser wheel and a range of bobbin and flyer options.

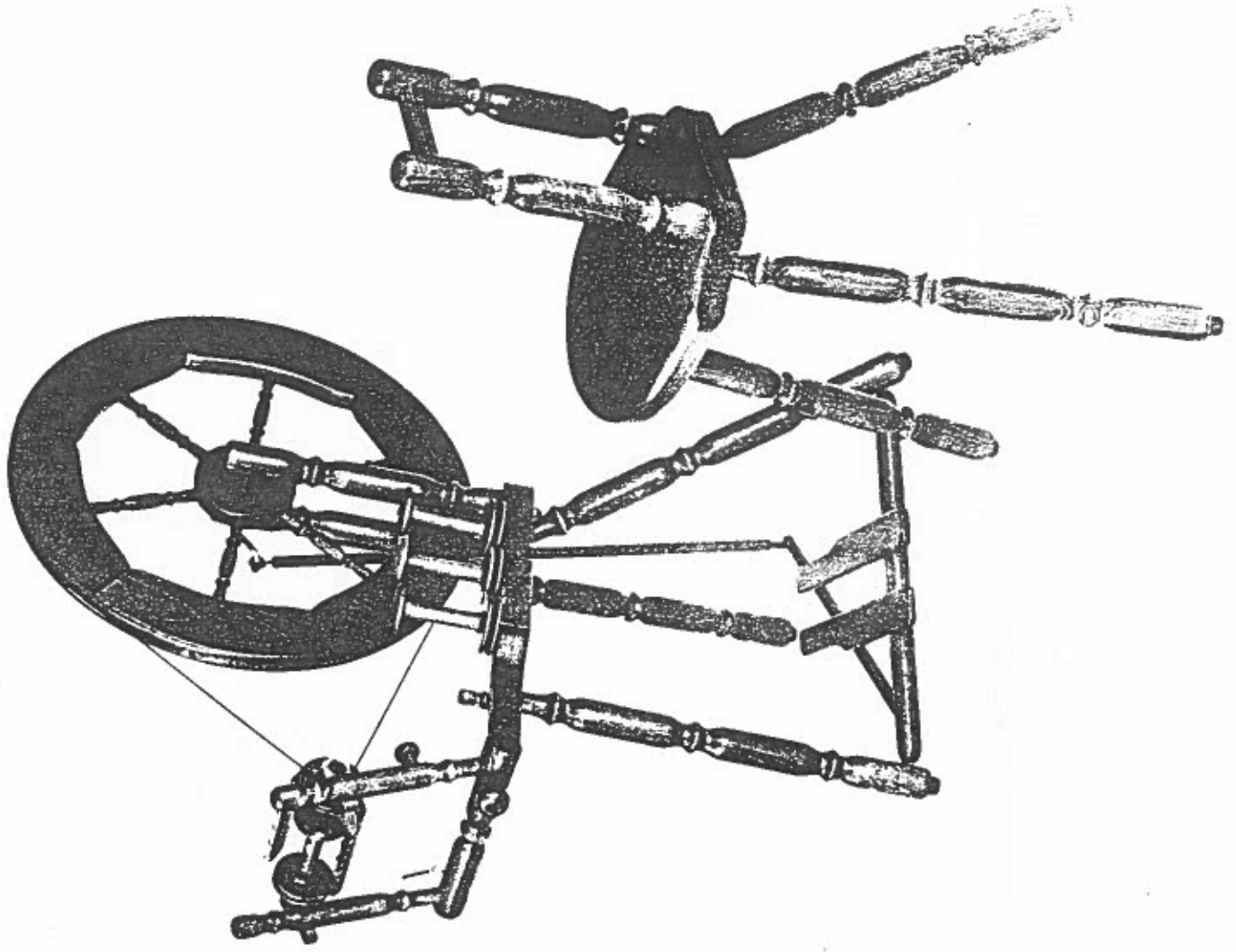
We now proudly introduce another radical departure from tradition, the new **Louët Saxony, S87**. The new **Saxony** wheel in many ways closes a circle in the development of spinning wheels.

The Louët factory is located in the easterly region of the Netherlands, the area where the Saksen people first settled. It is thus befitting that Louët introduces a wheel based on the traditional saxony design.

Looking closer however, you will discover that the wheel is a true Louët. It is made of light brown stained beech.

Carefull attention has been paid to the operation and ease of spinning. Scotch tension and available high ratio drive, makes this a wheel capable of more control with fine fibers. Four bobbins are included.

The three drive ratios are : 20:1, 11:1 and 7,5:1. Orifice : 3/8" (10 mm) Wheel diameter : 20" (50 cm).
